excel



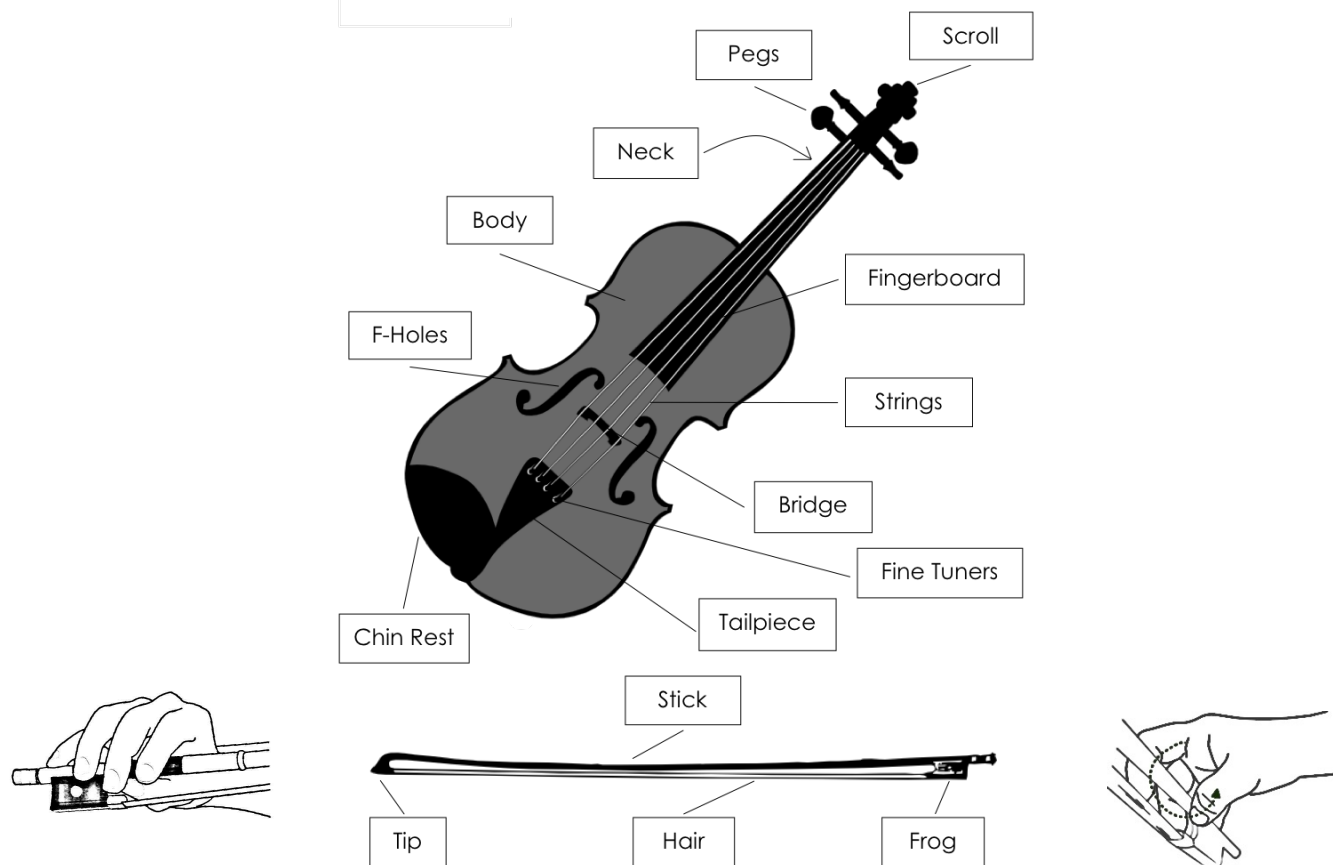
Try your hardest, do your best

No one can do better than their personal best! If you are trying your hardest, and doing your best then you are a success.

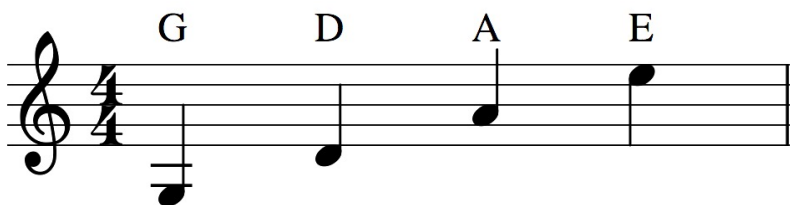

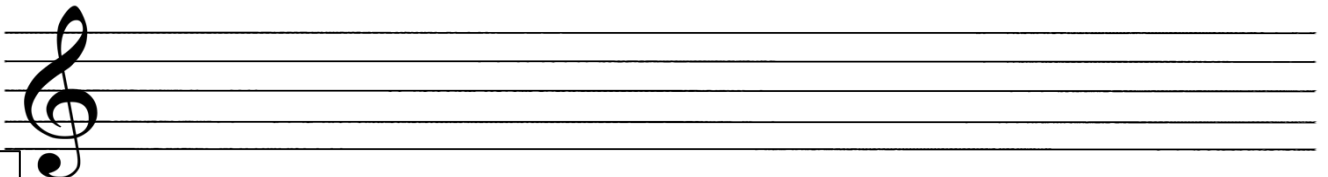


This is **two quavers** they last for **one beat**, say 'running'
